We've Been Going Green For a Long Time



Dear Members,

While the term “Green Power” continues to become more and more the topic of water-cooler conversations these days, it’s frankly nothing new to us. This year we celebrate 12 years of turning landfill gas into electricity at our Coffin Butte Resource Project just north of Corvallis. In fact, through PNGC Power, Douglas Electric and Umatilla Electric were two of the first electric utilities in Oregon to offer Green Power programs to its members.

As you will read on pages 28 and 29, we have begun to take the next step. On April 4th, I was on hand to help break ground for the expansion of Coffin Butte. The expansion project will essentially double the capacity of the facility, providing enough power to serve approximately 4,600 homes. Production will be the equivalent of burning 28,000 tons of coal per year, while eliminating 35,000 tons of greenhouse gas emissions in the process. As members of Douglas Electric Cooperative, you are also part-owners of the Coffin Butte project. The best news; the facility will be producing power at a very competitive rate.

You have an opportunity to contribute to the Coffin Butte project by joining our Green Power program. On page 25, you’ll find a little information about the program and subscription options. Please keep in mind, this doesn’t mean you’re getting specific kilowatts from Coffin Butte, but you are supporting Douglas Electric’s investment in the program as well as future endeavors as we grow and diversify our green power portfolio.
